On behalf of the Conference Committee, we invite you to attend the 2006 NAPLA Conference, to be held **June 7 - 10** in the Washington, D.C. area. The conference will be centered at George Mason University School of Law in Arlington, Virginia. Mark your calendars for this valuable program, and learn about recent developments in legal education and law school admissions, the current legal job market, and many other topics relevant to pre-law advising and law admissions! The conference theme is **“Y Law: Advising the Next Generation of Lawyers.”**

On Wednesday, June 7, Dr. Penny Rue from the University of Virginia will set the tone for the conference in a luncheon presentation entitled “Generations at Work”, (<http://www.itc.virginia.edu/virginia.edu/fall02/guest/home.html>). Also on June 7, training for new pre-law advisors and a workshop for veteran pre-law advisors will be offered, followed by a dinner and speaker program hosted by George Mason University School of Law. Conference attendees will have the opportunity to visit and attend program events at American University Washington College of Law, George Washington University Law School, and Georgetown University Law Center. Other conference events include workshops, plenary sessions, and a law school fair for pre-law advisors. On Friday night, the annual gala dinner at the National Press Club will feature a hilarious return performance of *Hexagon*, Washington's only not-for-profit original, political, satirical, musical, comedy revue (<http://www.hexagon.org/>). The conference ends around noon on Saturday, June 10.

Conference lodging reservations have been made at the FDIC's Seidman Center (one block from George Mason School of Law) and at the Holiday Inn Rosslyn@Key Bridge. Both hotel facilities are about one block from a Metro station (Orange Line). Further information on the hotel can be found in this booklet. **Please make your hotel reservations early!**

Transportation to all conference events will be included in the registration fee. Registrants will receive a Metro card and map for visits to George Washington and Georgetown, and to attend the gala at the National Press Club. American University has generously offered to provide bus transportation for the luncheon visit to American University Washington College of Law. If you are driving to the conference, parking will be available near George Mason; complimentary parking is also available if you are staying at the Holiday Inn Rosslyn@Key Bridge.
